0900-Noon "TECC Overview for LEO" (Tactical Emergency Casualty Care)
Instructor: Aaron Aitch, Field Operations Officer Franklin Co. Emergency Management Agency. Formally a Captain & Paramedic Olivette Fire Dept., Reserve Deputy Franklin Co. S.O. and serves as the SWAT medic for the county's team since July 2006. Recognized by the Missouri Sheriffs' Association as the "Reserve Deputy of the Year" for the State of Missouri in 2009.

The instructor will explain and demonstrate the techniques used to provide emergency care for yourself and others to better the chances for survival in the event of a traumatic incident. He will also explain and demonstrate the items that are required in an emergency go bag that should be kept in your vehicle or with you in the likely chance of an incident.

The instructor will cover the techniques and legal requirements of intercepting parcels containing contraband sent through the US Postal Service and other carriers. He will also

demonstrate how these techniques have worked by highlighting several case studies. This will include 1 hr of legal studies.
